Cross Timbers Operating Company hereby request administrative approval of an unorthodox gas well location for the above referenced well. Attached for your reference are the following exhibits:

- 3. Ownership Map with Offset Operators for the Pictured Cliffs formation.
- 4. Geologic discussion.
- 5. EUR Isopach Map of the Fruitland Coal and Pictured Cliffs Production
- 6. EUR Isopach Map of the Pictured Cliffs Sandstone.

For geological reasons, the optimal placement of a Pictured Cliffs well in the SW/4 spacing unit is the above requested location. Our objective in placement at this location is to drill as far as possible from the radius of any pre-existing or currently producing Pictured Cliffs wells, while at the same time maintaining maximum pay thickness and good reservoir quality to justify the drilling of the well. Pool rules state that a well will be no closer than 660' to the outer boundary of the well unit and 10' to a quarter-quarter section line.. To drill the well as a deviated hole would be cost prohibitive. The requested location provides the best location for the protection of waste and correlative rights.

Please note that the EUR Isopach maps provided show the original operator of the well drilled and do not necessarily represent the current operator.

By certified mail, a copy of this application and request for administrative approval has been sent to all Pictured Cliffs offsetting operators.





### **GEOLOGIC SUMMARY**


The Cross Timbers M.N. Galt "F" #1R is a proposed 2160' Pictured Cliffs well designed to be a re-drill of the M.N. Galt "F" #1, which produced approx. 931 MMCFG out of the Pictured Cliffs Ss. from 11/48 through 4/92. The M.N. Galt "F" #1 was recompleted to the Fruitland Coal in August 1997. The proposed location is situated approx. 1250' NNE of the M.N. Galt "F" #1, and approx. 1300' south of the M.N. Galt "G" #1 which was a Pictured Cliffs producer in the NW½, Sec. 1 from 8/51 to 7/90. That well made 435 MMCFG from the Pictured Cliff Ss., and is now plugged. There is currently no Pictured Cliffs well producing in the NW¼, Sec. 1 (the spacing unit towards which the proposed well is moving). CTOC owns the Pictured Cliffs rights under the NW¼, Sec. 1 and is the operator of that unit.


Cross Timbers' objective in the placement of the well is to drill away from the radius of influence of any pre-existing Pictured Cliffs wells, while at the same time maintaining sufficient pay thickness and good reservoir quality to justify the drilling of the well.

The Pictured Cliffs Sandstone was deposited as NW-SE trending marine coastal barrier sands oriented parallel to the Late Cretaceous Shoreline. Sand deposition gradually shifted northeastward as the shoreline regressed. Periodic stand-stills resulted in thicker and cleaner sand buildups, which directly correlate to NW-SE trends of prolific gas production.

Approx. 60 ft. of pay is expected at the proposed location. The good reservoir quality at the proposed location is supported by diagonal offset wells along trend to the NW and SE which have ultimate recoveries of 2013 MMCFG and 1613 MMCFG respectively.

An unorthodox location is recommended in order to move into the NW-SE trend of more prolific production and to gain distance away from the area drained by the original well in the unit.
