Your application indicates that the BLM is perhaps concerned about surface disturbance on this acreage. Please provide me with a detailed explanation (i) why the BLM is concerned and (ii) their connection with this half-section. Also provide me with details about the archeological considerations in this quarter section that prevents the drilling of this well at a standard Dakota gas well location.
