Dear Mr. Evans:

Reference is made to your application dated May 28, 2003 (*administrative application reference No. pKRV0-315455705*) for an exception to Rule 4 of the "Special Rules for the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-4314-A, as amended, for the Jicarilla Apache Energy Corporation's ("JAECO") existing Jicarilla Apache JV-5 Well No. 7 (API No. 30-039-27092) recently drilled at an unorthodox oil well location 1981 feet from the North line and 588 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 5, Township 23 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The NW/4 of Section 5, being a standard 160-acre, more or less, oil spacing and proration unit for the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool (39819), is to be dedicated to this well.

The subject application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F, revised by Division Order No. R-11231, issued by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Case No. 12119 on August 12, 1999, and the applicable provisions of the rules governing the West Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of: (i) Rule 5 of these special pool rules; and (ii) Division Rule 104.F (2), the unorthodox oil well location of JEACO's above-described Jicarilla Apache JV-5 Well No. 7 is hereby approved.
