Union Texas Petroleum Corporation is applying for an administrative downhole commingling order for the referenced well in the Basin Dakota, Wildhorse Gallup, and Blanco Mesaverde fields, as per Order #R-7508. The ownership of the zones to be commingled is common. The offset operator is Jerome P. McHugh & Associates. The Bureau of Land Management and this offset operator will receive notification of this proposed downhole commingling.

We are planning to drill this well during the summer of 1987. Prospective intervals in the Dakota, Gallup, and Mesaverde will be perforated and fractured separately. As with the offset wells, we anticipate that each of these formations would be marginal if produced separately. A dual completion would introduce waste since at least one side would be too weak to produce, or one interval would have to be squeezed, or both.

The following table lists others wells on our Jicarilla H lease that are commingled. These wells have not experienced any detrimental effects due to the commingling.

The reservoir characteristics of each of the subject zones are such that underground waste would not be caused by the proposed downhole commingling. The fluids from each zone are compatible and no precipitates will be formed to cause damage to either reservoir. The daily production will not exceed the limit of Rule 303c, Section 1a, Part 1. Both fluids have an API oil gravity close to 58°. The initial shut-in casing pressure for the Mesaverde, Gallup and Dakota are anticipated to be 900 psi, 950 psi, and 1550 psi, respectively.

The District Office in Aztec will be notified anytime the commingled well is shut-in for seven (7) consecutive days.

To allocate the commingled production to each of the zones, Union Texas Petroleum will consult with the District Supervisor of the Aztec District Office of the Division to determine an allocation formula for each of the productive zones.

Included with this letter is a plat showing ownership of offsetting leases, a letter to the offset operator, and wellbore diagram.


