South Vacuum 27 Well No. 3 2300 feet from the South line and 1100 feet from the East line (Unit I) Section 27, T-18-S, R-35-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Dear Mr. Fesmire:

Paladin Energy Corporation hereby seeks administrative approval pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 104.F for approval of an unorthodox oil well location for its existing South Vacuum 27 Well No. 3 in the Mississippian formation and any other potentially productive oil pools spaced on 40-acres. A standard 40-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 27 (Unit I) will be dedicated to this well.

The South Vacuum 27 Well No. 3 was drilled as a wildcat gas well in the McKee formation and is presently dedicated to the E/2 of Section 27. The location of this well was chosen to optimize its chances of success in the McKee gas formation. However, the well has not been successful in the McKee formation and therefore Paladin seeks to recomplete this well as an oil well in the Mississippian formation and dedicate to it the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 27. Paladin's proposed recompletion will result in an unorthodox oil well location under Rule 104.B (1) and encroach upon the NW/4 SE/4 (Unit J) by 110 feet.

Attachment A is a C-102 for this proposed well showing its location and footage. Attachment B is a land locator map showing the existing well, the proposed 40-acre spacing and proration unit, and the adjoining 40-acre spacing units and wells. Paladin is the record title owner of State Oil and Gas Lease V06744-0000 covering the NE/4

HOLLAND&HART.

SE/4 (Unit I) of said Section 27 where the well is located. Paladin is also the record title owner of State Oil and Gas Lease EO1635-0006 covering the NW/4 SE/4 (Unit J) of Section 27 that is affected by the unorthodox well location.

Paladin has met with the New Mexico State Land Office about its proposed recompletion. In order to ensure that each beneficiary institution of the State of New Mexico will receive its fair and equitable share of the oil recovered by this well, the New Mexico State Land Office has communitized the E/2 NW/4 SE/4 (State Lease EO1635-0006) and the W/2 NE/4 SE/4 (State Lease V06744-000). See Attachment C. Accordingly, there are no parties adversely affected by this application.


