Commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Harroun 15-15 Central Tank Battery located in Unit E of Section 15, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Oil and gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly. The commingled production from the wells is approved for off-lease measurement and sales.



FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division prior to implementation of commingling operations.
