Reference is made to your application received on September 4, 2013.

You have requested to drill this horizontal well at an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. Pursuant to Order No. R-6139-B, issued on September 24, 2013, spacing in the South Culebra Bone Spring Pool is now governed by statewide Rule 15.9.A [19.15.15.9.A NMAC], which provides for 40-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary, and Rule 15.16.14.B(2) [19.15.16.14.B(2) NMAC] concerning directional wells in designated project areas. This location is unorthodox because portions of the proposed completed interval are less than 330 feet from an outer boundary of the project area.

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Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location for engineering reasons.
