To whom it may concern:

On behalf of Logos Operating, LLC (“Logos”) and pursuant to Division Rules pertaining to Wildcat Oil Wells we hereby notify you of our intent to produce the Logos ~~9~~⁹ well on unorthodox well location for the to be located 1400’ FNL and 355’ FEL of Section 5, T22N, R5W NMPM in Sandoval County. The SE/4NE/4 of Section 5 will be dedicated to the well.

The wildcat rules for oil wells provide that wells shall be drilled not closer than 330’ to any quarter-quarter section boundary. The location proposed for this well is consequently unorthodox by approximately 250’ to the east. The C-102 plat showing the proposed location for the well is attached hereto.


Logos seeks an exception from the applicable well location rules for the following reasons: The chosen location was most practical based operational efficiencies and on BLM onsite which identified multiple cultural and environmental issues.
