On October 30, 2013, Chevron U.S.A. Inc. (Chevron) submitted an application requesting the authority and administrative approval for unorthodox well location for lease line production well and simultaneous dedication (see attached).




VICINITY MAP



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**SECOND AMENDMENT TO VACUUM AREA COOPERATIVE LEASE LINE
AGREEMENT**

STATE OF NEW MEXICO §

COUNTY OF LEA §

THIS AMENDMENT is entered between CHEVRON U.S.A. INC., Successor-in-interest to TEXACO EXPLORATION AND PRODUCTION INC., ("CHEVRON") as Operator and sole working interest owner in the Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit, and CHEVRON USA INC. as Operator and on behalf of all the working interest owners in the Central Vacuum Unit ("Unit Operator").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Unit Operator is the Operator of the Central Vacuum Unit covering certain leases and lands, located in Townships 17 South and 18 South, Ranges 34 East and 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, as shown on Exhibit "A" and more particularly described in the Central Vacuum Unit Agreement to which reference is made for purposes of description; and

WHEREAS, Chevron is the Operator of the Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit covering, among other lands, the following described land in Lea County, New Mexico:

Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico, as shown on Exhibit "A" and more particularly described in the Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit Agreement to which reference is made for purposes of Description; and

WHEREAS, Unit Operator and Chevron are parties to that certain Vacuum Area Cooperative Lease Line Agreement dated March 1, 1996 in the interest of more properly producing and conserving the oil and gas from the Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit and the Central Vacuum Unit; and

WHEREAS, by Amendment to Vacuum Area Cooperative Lease Line Agreement dated November 19, 2007 effective December 1, 2007, Provision I of this agreement was amended to add the Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit Well Nos. 405 and 412 for the production oil and gas from the Grayburg and San Andres formations:

WHEREAS, Unit Operator and Chevron now desire to amend Provision I of said Vacuum Area Cooperative Lease Line Agreement, as amended, for the purpose of drilling an additional producing well at or near the Unit lines between the Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit and Central Vacuum Unit in order to further enhance the ultimate recovery of hydrocarbons from the lands and Units;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises, Unit Operator and Chevron have agreed and do by these presents herein agree that Provision I found on page 1 of the Vacuum Area Cooperative Lease Line Agreement shall be further amended to read as follows:

I.

Chevron will drill and equip the well listed below for the purpose of production of oil and gas from the Grayburg and San Andres formations:

Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit Well No. 113, located 670 feet from the South line and 175 feet from the East line of Section 1, T-18-S, R-34-E

The above well and all the current existing wells subject to the Vacuum Area Cooperative Lease Line Agreement are located in Lea County, New Mexico as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

Unit Operator and Chevron further agree to amend the Vacuum Area Cooperative Lease Line Agreement to add the following Provisions VII and VIII:

VII.

Additional producing well or wells may be drilled within the lease line area within the two Units without any further action required from the working interest and royalty owners to this agreement.

VIII.

Should any of the locations for the well or wells listed (or future wells to be listed) above deviate slightly while drilling from the surface location to the bottom hole location, it is agreed that the well or wells will be equipped at a locations drilled and completed without further action required from the parties to this agreement. All of the above wells (or wells to be listed) are located in Lea County, New Mexico as shown (or to be shown) on the map attached as Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

All remaining terms and conditions of the original Vacuum Area Cooperative Lease Line Agreement, excepting those herein amended, shall remain unchanged and shall in full force and effect.





Dear Mr. Bailey,

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. (Chevron) hereby makes an application requesting the authority and administrative approval for unorthodox well location for lease line production well and simultaneous dedication, and in support hereof states:

1. Chevron is the operator of the Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit and the Central Vacuum Unit;
2. The Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit was approved by the Division by Order No. R-4433, issued in Case 4851 dated November 8, 1972 and a pressure maintenance project by water flood was authorized for this Unit by Division Order No. R-4442, issued in Case 4852 dated November 27, 1972; and a tertiary recovery project by the injection of CO₂ was authorized for this Unit by Division Order No. R-4442-B, issued in Case 13961 dated December 11, 2007;
3. The Central Vacuum Unit was approved by Division Order No. R-5496, issued in Case 5907 dated August 9, 1977, and a waterflood project was authorized for this Unit by Division Order No. R-5530, issued in Case 6008 dated September 20, 1977;
4. Although the Vacuum-Grayburg San Andres Pool is governed by the Division's statewide rules for spacing and the location of wells which provide for 40-acre proration units, the effective spacing units for this pool was reduced to 20 acres in the 1970's and early 1980's and there was sporadic infill drilling on 10-acre spacing in the late 1980's and early 1990's;
5. Chevron's evaluation of the reservoir showed substantial additional reserves would be recovered with development on 10-acre spacing. This was confirmed by the successful drilling of 14 ten-acre wells in 1995;
6. Chevron seeks authority to drill the following unorthodox well location and simultaneous

dedication for the following lease line production well:

Well: Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit Well No. 113
Location: 670' FSL & 175' FEL (Unit Letter P)
Well Unit: SE/4SE/4 of Section 1, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M.,
Lea County, New Mexico to produce oil as a lease line producer;

The SE/4SE/4 of Section 1 will be simultaneously dedicated to Well No. 113 and the Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit Wells 43, 143, 122, 250 and 235.

7. This well will be operated pursuant to the Vacuum Area Cooperative Lease Line Agreement dated March 1, 1996 (as amended on November 19, 2007, but effective December 1, 2007) and as amended on September 12, 2013, but effective September 1 2013 which has been approved by Chevron U.S.A. Inc. which owns 100% of the working interest in the Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit and by the owners of 94.8% of the working interest in the Central Vacuum Unit. The request for approval of this agreement was submitted to the Commissioner of Public Lands, State of New Mexico on October 30, 2013 which owns 100% of the royalty interest in the Vacuum Grayburg San Andres Unit and 99% of the royalty interest in the Central Vacuum Unit. The States' final approval is expected prior to November 8, 2013.
8. Pursuant to this Amendment to Vacuum Area Cooperative Lease Line Agreement (see item 1 below), half of the production from the proposed wells will be allocated to each Unit;
9. Approval of this application will result in an efficient production pattern for each of these waterflood projects and will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.


