The incident was caused by power failure due to a faulty check valve and ball valve at well head causing back-flow through H-pump. Recovered 35 bbls of produced water from unlined dike. Shut well in till water levels in tanks returned to normal and replaced faulty connections on well head. Electricians restored power to H-pump and returned well to service.
