The commingled gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Roadrunner Well No. 4G central tank battery (CTB), located in Unit G Section 2, Township 24 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.


The operator shall notify the Aztec District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
