Linn Operating, Inc. ("Linn") recently proposed the above mentioned wells in Lea County, New Mexico. Each well is a Non-Standard Location ("NSL") which means it is less than 330' from the quarter-quarter boundary.

The first well, the Phillips Lea #105, is located 2,273 FEL, 1,065 FSL in Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 34 East. It is encroaching on the NW/4 SE/4 (J). Linn is the operator of the leasehold in (J) which is held by State of New Mexico Oil and Gas Lease B-4118; therefore, the NSL will not be draining another operator.

The second well, the State 36 #102, is located 2,615 FEL, 1,205 FSL in Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 33 East. It is encroaching on the NW/4 SE/4 (J) and SE/4 SW/4 (N). Linn is the operator of this leasehold in (J) and (N) which is held by State of New Mexico Oil and Gas Lease V-3349; therefore, the NSL will not be draining another operator.


