Pursuant to Division Rule 19.15.15.13, Apache Corporation ("Apache") respectfully requests administrative approval of an unorthodox oil well location for its proposed Raven Federal No. 19H. This well will be drilled as a horizontal development oil well in the Cedar Lake Glorieta-Yeso Pool (96831) at the unorthodox horizontal oil well location described above.

The proposed Raven Federal No. 19H will be dedicated to an existing 151.89-acre spacing unit/horizontal project area in the Cedar Lake Glorieta-Yeso Pool comprising Lot 4, SE/4 SW/4 and the S/2 SE/4 (S/2 S/2) of Section 7, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM. This unit is currently dedicated to Apache's proposed: i) Raven Federal No. 20H (API No. 30-015-40917 located at a surface location 420 feet from the South line and 180 feet from the East line, and a bottomhole location 420 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line; and ii) Raven Federal No. 21H (API No. 30-015-40918) located at a surface location 330 feet from the South line and 180 feet from the East line, and a bottomhole location 330 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line.

The Cedar Lake Glorieta-Yeso Pool is currently governed by Division Rule 19.19.15.9 which requires standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration units with wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, or in the case of a horizontal well, no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the project area.

Apache is currently testing increased horizontal well drilling density in this area. As part of that study, the Raven Federal No. 19H will be situated within the proposed spacing unit in an area that will likely not be drained by the proposed Raven Federal Wells No. 20H and 21H. Consequently, the proposed unorthodox location is necessary in order to maximize the recovery of oil and gas reserves from the Cedar Lake Glorieta-Yeso Pool underlying the proposed project area.

The affected offset tracts are: i) Lot 3, NE/4 SW/4 and N/2 SE/4 (N/2 S/2) of Section 7. This existing 151.78-acre horizontal project area is currently operated by Apache in the Cedar Lake-Glorieta Yeso Pool. Please note that the working interest ownership between this affected offset tract and the drilling tract is common; and ii) the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 12, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, NMPM. This unit is currently operated in the Cedar Lake Glorieta-Yeso Pool by Burnett Oil Company, Inc.

Notice of this application is being provided to Burnett Oil Company, Inc. in accordance with Division rules.

Attached is a Form C-102 showing the proposed well and spacing unit. Also attached is a map showing the affected offset acreage.

In summary, approval of the application will provide Apache Corporation the opportunity to recover additional oil and gas reserves from the Cedar Lake Glorieta-Yeso Pool underlying the S/2 S/2 of Section 7 that may otherwise not be recovered by the proposed producing wells, thereby preventing waste, and will not violate correlative rights.


