This requested amendment is approved, and COG Operating, LLC (OGRID 229137) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from Atoka; Glorieta-Yeso Pool (3250) from the following leases and wells:

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Patton 5 Fee Well No. 8H central tank battery (CTB), located in Unit M, of Section 5, Township 19 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Oil and gas production from the Patton 5 Fee Well No. 7H, and Patton 5 Fee Well No. 8H shall be measured based on subtraction method. The Patton 5 Fee Well No. 6H shall be separately metered before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

The installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with applicable Division rules. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operation.

This order supersedes Order No. CTB-721, issued on July 8, 2014.
