- 1. The oil production from the Graham Nash State Com Well No. 008H shall be measured at, and sold from, Graham Nash State Com Well No. 008H Central Tank Battery (Graham Nash State Com Well No. 008H CTB) in D-28-26S-28E.
- 2. Gas production from Graham Nash State Com Well No. 008H shall be measured separately at the Graham Nash State Com Well No. 008H CTB before commingling at the gatherer's meter located at the same battery.

- 3. The oil production from the Graham Nash Federal Com Well No. 007H shall be measured at, and sold from, Graham Nash Federal Com Well No. 007H Central Tank Battery (Graham Nash Federal Com Well No. 007H CTB) in M-21-26S-28E.
- 4. Gas production from the Graham Nash Federal Com Well No. 007H shall be measured separately at the Graham Nash Federal Com Well No. 007H CTB before commingling at the gatherer's meter located at the Graham Nash State Com Well No. 008H CTB.
- 5. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly per Paragraph (2) of Subsection C of 19.15.12.10 NMAC.

Your application has been filed per Subsection C of 19.15.12.10 NMAC and Paragraph (8) of Subsection A of 19.15.4.12 NMAC.

COG has given notice of this application to all owners in the mineral interest estate ("affected parties") per Paragraph (4) of Subsection C of 19.15.12.10 NMAC.

COG shall install and operate these facilities per Division rules. COG shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

This administrative order is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management and New Mexico State Land Office.

COG shall notify the Artesia District Office of the Division prior to starting the commingling operations.
