Reference is made to your application received on December 20, 2018.

You have requested to recomplete this vertical well within another formation at an unorthodox gas well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by Division Rule 19.15.15.10.B NMAC, which provides for 320-acre units, with wells to be located at least 660 feet from outer unit boundaries.

This well's completed interval is as close as 383 feet to the eastern edge of the project area. Encroachments will impact the following tracts.

Section 23, T26N R08W encroachment to the SW4

Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Paragraph (2) of Subsection A of 19.15.4.12 NMAC, in all

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adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches. However, the ownership is identical in the W2 Section 23; therefore, notice is not required.
