EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Python 36 State Com No. 703H Well** (API No. 30-025-45696) to be completed within the WC-025 G-09 S253309P; Upper Wolfcamp Pool (98180) underlying the W/2 W/2 of Section 36, Township 24 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 546 feet from the south line and 1,716 feet from the west line (Unit N) of Section 36. The upper most perforation will be located 100 feet from the south line and 1,255 feet from the west line (Unit M) of Section 36 and the lower most perforation will be 100 feet from the north line and 1,255 feet from the west line (Unit D) of Section 36. Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than 330 feet to the eastern boundary of the spacing unit. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow EOG to use their preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area and thereby prevent waste.

Exhibit A is a revised Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Python 36 State Com No. 703H Well** encroaches on the drilling and spacing unit to the east.

Exhibit B is a land plat for Section 36 that shows the proposed **Python 36 State Com No. 703H Well** in relation to adjoining units and existing wells in Section 36. This exhibit also shows EOG's well spacing pattern for the subject area.



T-24-S, R-32-E, LEA COUNTY **UNORTHODOX LOCATION APPLICATION** PYTHON 36 STATE COM # 703H



To Whom it may concern:

After further reviewing the distance between wells in the development plan for the Wolfcamp formation as well as the location of the existing wells in Section 36-T24S-R32E, EOG has adjusted the development plan for the section and believes the new non-standard location for the 703H is necessary to develop the Wolfcamp resource in an economic fashion. Based on current Wolfcamp wells in Section 36-T24S-R32E, placing the well at this location prevents completion energy distribution to be skewed into a region of lower pressure caused by offset depletion, negatively impacting well's production. Granting the exception will allow for more total production from the section and more efficient development of the asset therefore protecting correlative rights.


