Dear Mr. Wade and Mr. Jones:

I am sending this letter on behalf of the New Mexico State Land Office to object to the January 30, 2019 application for Foundation Minerals Fee SWD No. 1 Authorization to Inject, filed by Lonquist & Co. on behalf of 3Bear Field Service, LLC.

19.15.26.8 NMAC discusses the method for applying to inject water into a formation for disposal. The operator must apply for authority by submitting form C-108. Additionally, 19.15.26.8(B)(2) requires the applicant to furnish, by certified or registered mail, a copy of the application to each owner of the land surface on which each injection or disposal well is to be located and to each leasehold operator or other affected person within any tract wholly or partially contained within one-half mile of the well.

The State Land Office should have been notified regarding the 3Bear Field Service applications as an affected person due to the proximity of state trust minerals and surface. The proposed Foundation Minerals Fee SWD No. 1 is located in Unit L Section 4, T24S, R27E, which is within a ½ mile of State Trust surface and minerals.

The State Land Office is concerned about the potential effect the proposed SWD wells may have on state trust minerals and requests additional time to review the application.
