Dear Mr. McClure:

Apache would like to amend Administrative Surface Commingling Order PLC-644 to remove the verbiage regarding quarterly testing, as listed in Item 8 of the Order, stated as follows:

“8. Applicant shall submit a Form C-103 each quarter to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe that identifies the following information for each well: (a) the allocation method; (b) the current decline rate; (c) the minimum number of well tests per month required by Paragraphs 6 or 7, as applicable; and (d) the number of well tests conducted each month.”

Apache currently more than meets the minimum testing requirements, as well as Federal Standards. There is also a voluntary Joint Operating Agreement in effect to cover any variances in ownership, as provided in the original surface commingle application.
