

Mr. Goins,

Select Energy is proposing to drill and operate a Saltwater Disposal Well (SWD) (Vary 1 Federal SWD No. 1) in Section 35 Township 23S Range 32E in Lea County, NM. Although this location is outside of the SOPA and KPLA, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) has advised us that the proposed location is within the Polynatura Potash Application Area, but is outside of the Polynatura active mine works. As such, NMOCD has requested that we provide verification and approval of this SWD location from PolyNatura prior to approval of the application.

A map showing the location of the Varys 1 Federal SWD #1 in relation to the SOPA and KPLA is attached.

Could you please let me know whether or not Polynatura has an issue with the location of this proposed SWD so we can pass it on to the NMOCD?
