Dear Mr. McClure:

XTO Energy Inc. (XTO) request the Administrative Order referenced be amended to remove verbiage requiring the quarterly filing of NMOCD Form C-103 as written in the Conditions of Approval as follows:

"Operator shall submit a Sundry Notice (C-103) to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe when the planned number of well tests per month decreases due to the well transitioning to a production period in which the well requires fewer well tests per month. The Sundry Notice shall include production curves and a decline rate curve demonstrating that the well meets the conditions to require fewer well tests per month."

XTO currently meets or exceeds the minimum testing requirements, as well as Federal standards.
