RE: Amend Administrative Order PLC-649 James Ranch Unit DI11 Battery Eddy County, NM

Dear Mr. McClure:

XTO Permian Operating LLC. (XTO) request the Administrative Order referenced be amended to remove verbiage requiring the quarterly filing of NMOCD Form C-103 as written in the Conditions of Approval as follows:

"4. Applicant shall submit a Form C-103 each quarter to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe that identifies the allocation method for each well, and for any well allocated by the well test method, Applicant shall provide the following information: (a) the current decline rate; (b) the minimum number of well tests per month required by the Order; and (c) the number of well tests conducted each month."

XTO currently meets or exceeds the minimum testing requirements, as well as Federal standards.
