Reference is made to your application received on January 20, 2021.

You have requested to complete this horizontal well as a gas well described above in the referenced pool or formation. This well is governed by special rules, R-14262, for the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool and provides for 320-acre units, with wells located at least 330 feet from a unit outer boundary.

This well's completed interval is as close as 10 feet to the southern edge and 50 feet to the northern edge. Encroachment will impact the following tract.

Section 19, encroachment to the NW/4
Section 34, 25S 28E, encroachment to the SW/4

The Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in Paragraph (8) Subsection A of 19.15.2.7 NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches.


Division understands you are seeking this unorthodox location to allow for spacing in order to optimize recovery of minerals in place and thus preventing waste within the Wolfcamp formation underlying the W/2 of Section 18, W/2 of Section 7 and the W/2 of Section 6.

Your application has been filed under 19.15.16.15(C)(6) NMAC, 19.15.15.13 NMAC and 19.15.4.12 (A)(2) NMAC.

Per Subsection B of 19.15.15.13 NMAC, **Division approves this unorthodox location.**
