NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN; That Anthem Water Solutions, LLC, 5914 W. Courtyard Dr., Suite 320, Austin Texas, 78730, is requesting that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division administratively approve the APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY TO INJECT as follow:

PURPOSE: The intended purpose of the injection well is to dispose of salt water produced from permitted oil and gas wells.

WELL NAME AND LOCATION: Caracara 232534 Federal SWD 1 Located 14 miles west of Jal. SWSE Section 23, Township 25S, Range 34E, 49' from South Line & 2489' from East Line, Lea County, New Mexico.

NAME AND DEPTH OF DISPOSAL ZONE: Devonian-Silurian (17245' – 18298')

EXPECTED MAXIMUM INJECTION RATE: 30,000 barrels/day

EXPECTED MAXIMUM INJECTION PRESSURE: 3449 psi (surface)
