You have requested this non-standard horizontal spacing in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights to maximize the recovery of oil and gas reserves within the N/2 S/2, SW/4 NE/4 & S/2 NW/4 of Section 2 and the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 3.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 19.15.16.15(B)(5) NMAC, the above-described **non-standard horizontal spacing unit is hereby approved**.
