Reference is made to your application received on August 17, 2011.

You have requested to drill or re-complete this well at an unorthodox gas well location described above, in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by statewide Rule 15.9.B [19.15.15.10.B NMAC], which provides for 320-acre units, with wells located at least 660 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is less than 660 feet from a unit boundary.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location in order to utilize an existing wellbore.
