


Based on site ranking of "0" and the small amount of fluid lost, Yates Petroleum Corporation requests closure.**

Jeremy,

The C-141 submitted for the above referenced release was submitted as an Initial and Final report. It indicates a backhoe was dispatched and removed contaminated soils. Do you know if any samples were obtained from the excavation?

There was another release reported for this same well (DOR: 8/26/11). The source of both releases was listed as a flowline. Assuming both releases were from the same flowline, do you know if they were in the same place? The lat/long is listed as the same for both releases, but may be the lat/long of the well and not the actual releases. The first release was a net 7 bbl oil release with the second being reported as a net 8 bbl oil/produced water release. The first release proposes to obtain samples while the second release is requesting closure.
