On 11-1-11 at 8:00am a spill of produced water was found at the Nervous Horz #3 battery. The spill originated from the bottom of the filter pot which rotted out. 200bbls of produced water was released into the lined dike. 199bbls were recovered. A vacuum truck picked up all standing fluid and contaminated gravel will be hauled to CRI. The 40 mil battery liner will be steamed and refilled with new gravel.
