- (d) fluoranthene
- (e) fluorene
- (f) phenanthrene
- (g) pyrene

P.P.S.: Also, please keep in mind that the WQCC standard for benzo(a)pyrene is 0.0007 mg/L (therefore, the detection limit must be no greater than 0.0007 mg/L, not 0.0102 as indicated in Table 3).
