
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A 1/2 inch pipe on the lact unit broke causing crude oil to leak onto the ground. Upon discovery, the valves on the back of the tanks were closed, stopping the flow of oil to the lact.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* On the site pad, an area approximately 6'x20'. Off the pad, into the pasture an area approximately 30'x80'. Per lact readings we lost approximately 50bbls, recovered approximately 5bbls. Hungry Horse responded to begin clean up. An archeological survey was completed. All contaminated soil was removed and disposed of at CRI in Hobbs, NM and replaced with new caliche, sand and top soil in the appropriate areas. The pasture was reseeded. A new 2' high containment barrier was placed around the north, west and south sides of the pad to prevent future disturbance of surrounding pasture lands. A new fence was placed around the north, west & south sides to help deter livestock from entering the pad site. All reclamation work was completed by Hungry Horse LLC. on Thursday February 16th, 2012.
