Reference is made to your application received on February 13, 2012.

You have requested to re-complete this well at an unorthodox gas well location described above, in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by statewide Rule 15.10.B [19.15.15.10.B NMAC], which provides for 320-acre units, with wells located at least 660 feet from a unit outer boundary. This location is less than 660 feet from a unit boundary.



Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location in order to utilize and existing wellbore.

It is also understood that notice to offsetting operators or owners is unnecessary due to common ownership.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 15.13.B, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
