Travis,

Sorry for not calling. Our email server was down most of the day yesterday so I just got your email this morning. One thing I will need for processing the C-141 and moving forward is the well number the release is associated with. I think there are over 40 wells in the Double L Queen, so I will need that.

For remediation, typically, OCD will require any highly contaminated/saturated soils to be excavated and hauled to an approved disposal. I believe the closest disposal in that area will be Gandy/Marley. Representative samples will then need to be obtained in the affected area and sent to a lab for analyses. What needs to be done after that will be based on the analytical data and some site specific conditions, such as depth to ground water. Since it sounds like there was a large "overspray" area, it would be a possibility to address that area without excavation.

There are several environmental contractors around this area that specialize in cleaning up these events, and are familiar with what the regulatory agencies require for remedial actions. If you want to consider that, I can't recommend any one specifically, but could provide some contact numbers for a few in the area.
