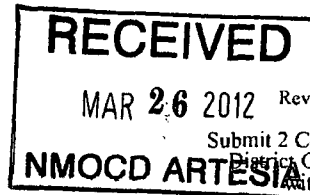




A flowline inside our Berry A Tank Battery ruptured and released fluid. The old steel flowline has been replaced with a new poly flowline.					
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken *					
Initially 10bbls were released from the flowline and we were able to recover roughly 8bbls with a vacuum truck. The entire release was contained inside the facility walls of the tank battery. The spill area measures 13' x 50' inside the tank battery. The flowline that ruptured is from the Berry A #10 well (API#) 30-015-30289. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a work plan to the NMOC D/BLM for approval prior to any significant remediation work.

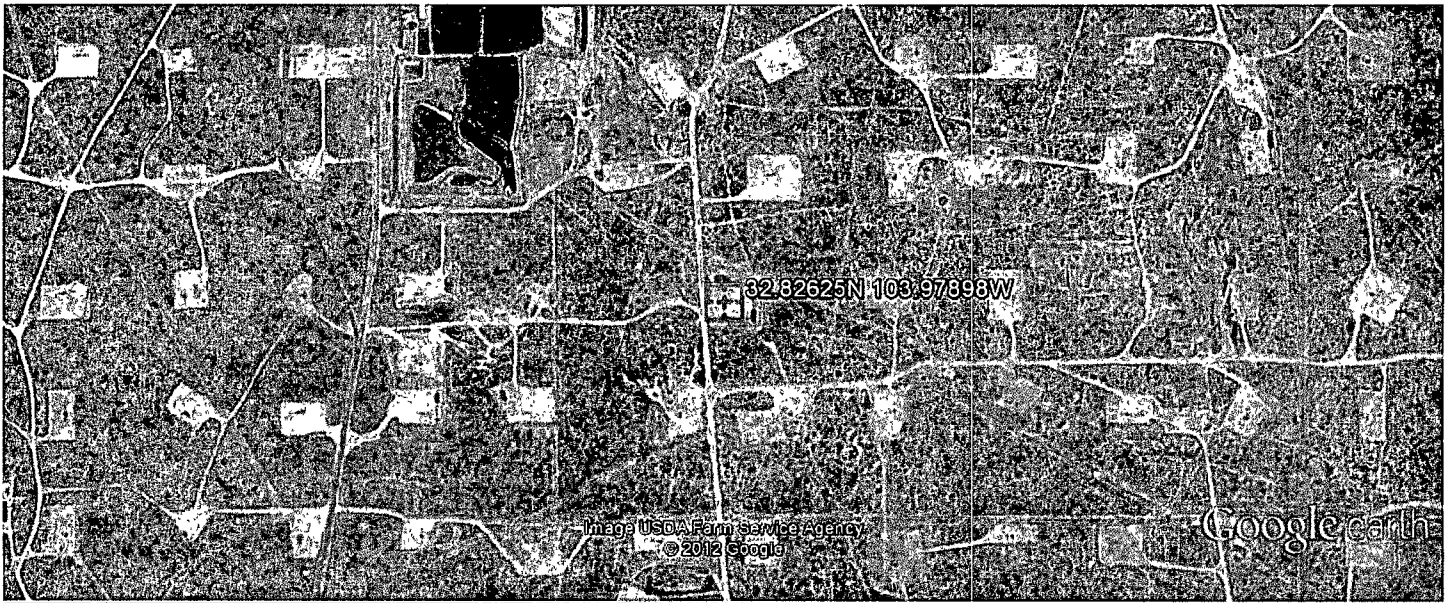

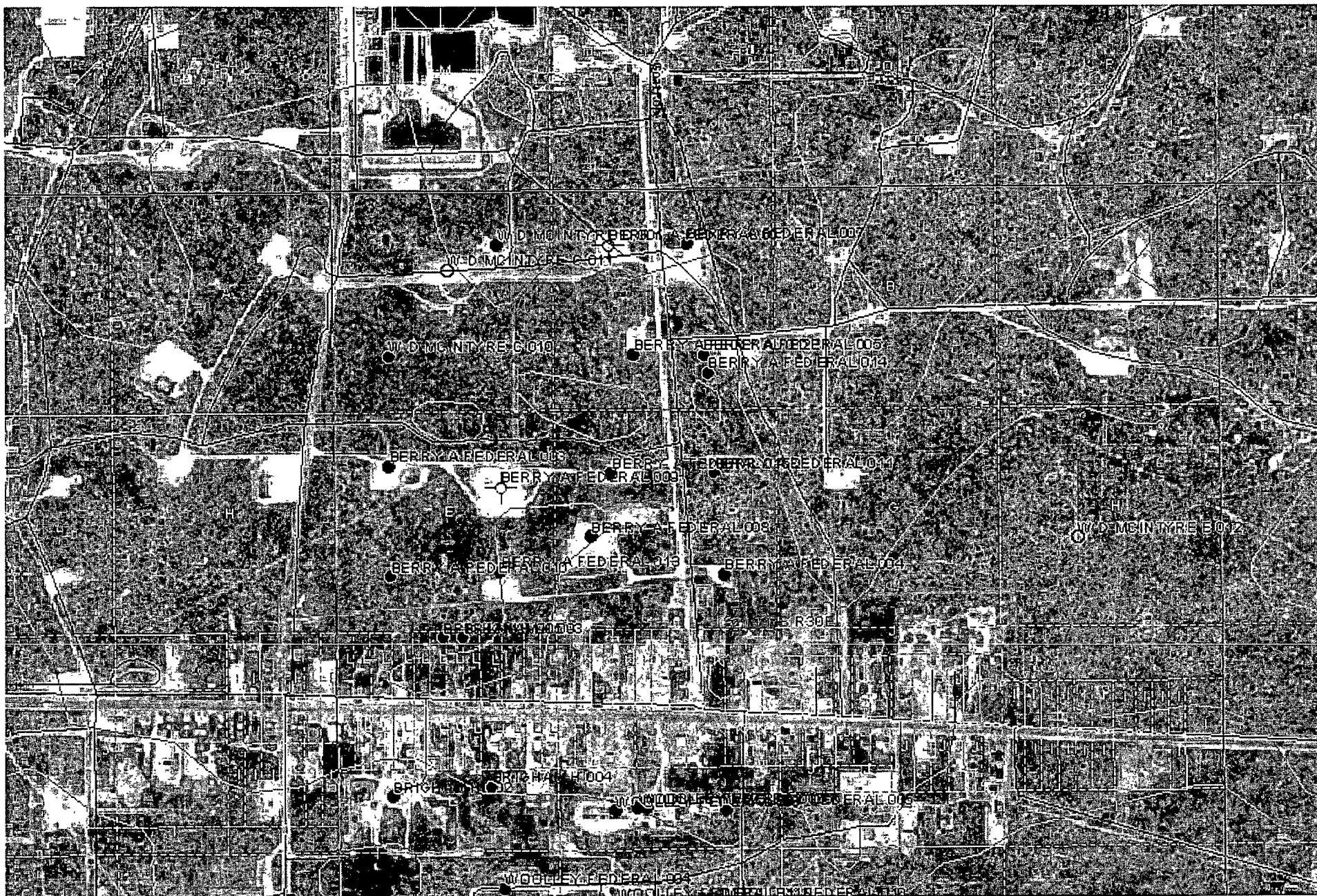
