County, New Mexico. Oil production from the wells is approved for off lease measurement and sales.


Oil production from the wells shall be measured and allocated back to each well by monthly periodic Well Tests. This Commingled Battery Testing and Allocation Procedures as detailed in the application is made part of this order.

The producer/operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Artesia district office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.

This approval is subject to like approval from the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) before commencement of the commingling operations.
