Dear Mr. Brooks:

Pursuant to NMAC 19.15.15.13, Mewbourne Oil Company applies for approval of an unorthodox oil well location for the following well:

<u>Well:</u>	Marathon Road 14 Fed. Com. Well No. 2
<u>Surface location:</u>	330 feet FSL & 510 feet FEL
<u>Penetration point:</u>	Same as surface location
<u>Beginning of producing interval:</u>	335 feet FSL and 1082 feet FEL
<u>Bottom hole location:</u>	370 feet FSL & 330 feet FWL
<u>Well unit (project area):</u>	S½S½ of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico

The well will be drilled to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation (Lea-Bone Spring Pool). Under Order No. R-1827-A, the pool has 80 acre spacing, with wells to be located within 150 feet of the center of a quarter-quarter section. A form C-102 is attached as **Exhibit A**.

The surface location was selected to accommodate the fee surface owner. The well is essentially being drilled on statewide location rules to maximize the productive length of the wellbore.

A land plat identifying offset working interest owners/operators to the west, southwest, and south is attached as **Exhibit B**. Notice was given to the offsets by the letter attached as **Exhibit C**.
