The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received the Rice Operating Company's (ROC) Soil Closure Request for the Abatement Plan (AP-75) for the BD J-26 Site, dated October 11, 2012. The above-referenced report, submitted in partial fulfillment of 19.15.30.19 NMAC (Part 30.19, formally, Rule 19.K), indicates that ROC has partially met the requirements of 19.15.30.9 NMAC for this site.
