

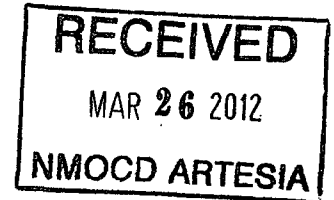

All, this email is to inform you of a Reportable leak that Oxy Permian had at the Amax 24 # 8 on January 24, 2012 . Total release was 30 bbls of oil and water mix, with 0 recovered. The leak was due to failure of end cap on rental Frac Tank. Battery is located in Section 24, Township 23s, and Range 31E of Eddy County. Oxy will be performing some initial clean up of the surface soils and gathering soil samples to be tested for impact in the near future. A C-141 will follow.

Oxy had an additional reportable leak at the Cypress 34 Fed 4H on January 30, 2012 . Total release was 45 bbls of oil and water mix, with 0 recovered. The leak was due to overfilling of tank during flowback . Battery is located in Unit D Section 34, Township 23s, and Range 29E of Eddy County. Oxy will be performing some initial clean up of the surface soils and gathering soil samples to be tested for impact in the near future. A C-141 will follow.
