

Dear Ms. Bailey:

Three Rivers Operating Company (OGRID No. 272295) hereby seeks administrative approval pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 19.15.15.13 NMAC for an unorthodox well location for its Tiger 11 Federal No. 1H well to be located in Section 11, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed well is to be drilled at a surface location 30 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 11. The bottomhole location will be 330 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 11. A 160-acre project area has been dedicated to this horizontal well comprised of the W/2 W/2 of Section 11.

Exhibit A is a land plat for Section 11 and surrounding sections that shows the proposed non-standard location of the Tiger 11 Federal No. 1H well in relation to adjoining units. This location is unorthodox because the Lea-Bone Spring Pool (Pool Code 37570) under this acreage is provides for wells to be located within 150 feet of the center of any quarter-quarter section. The completed interval of the lateral well bore as proposed will be closer than 150 feet from the center of the non-standard spacing and proration unit dedicated to this well and, therefore, will be at an unorthodox location.

Exhibit B is the Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the proposed Tiger 11 Federal No. 1H well encroaches on the spacing and proration units to North, East, and South.



Exhibit C is a list of the affected parties. Pursuant to 19.15.4.12(A)(2)(c) NMAC, affected parties are those toward whom the non-standard location encroaches. Here, well bore encroaches to the North, which is a unit operated by Three Rivers in the Bone Spring formation. The affected parties, therefore, include the State Land Office as trustee of the state mineral interest and Armstrong Energy, which is the operator of the working interest in zones shallower than the Bone Spring. The well bore also encroaches to the East, which is a unit also operated by Three Rivers Operating. The affected party, therefore, is the mineral owner who is the Bureau of Land Management. The well bore also encroaches to the South, which is a unit operated by Read & Stevens. A copy of this application with all attachments was mailed to all the notice recipients indicated in Exhibit C.


