This letter confirms our recent conversation concerning the error in the application we filed on behalf of EOG Resources, Inc. in the above referenced matter. The correct location for the Red Hills North Unit well No. 106 is 2000 feet from the South line – not 2000 feet from the North line as shown on the Injection Well Data Sheet included in the application. The area of review for this well is correctly shown and all other information in this application is correct.

Pursuant to our conversation, we have again notified the surface owner and the other interest owner in the area of review and attach a revised Notice Affidavit. We have also arranged for a corrected legal advertisement to be run in the Hobbs-News Sun. We will provide you with the Affidavit of Publication as soon as it is received.

The inability to inject water is causing EOG to restrict production in the unit. We therefore request that the Division expedite approval of this application to the fullest extent possible.




