

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A failed weld on a poly flowline allowed for the release of fluid We have fused the line and returned it to service.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Initially 145bbbls were released from the flowline and we were able to recover 130bbbls with a vacuum truck. The spill area was located to the southwest of the Electra Federal #5 Tank Battery. All free fluids have been recovered. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOC D/BLM for approval prior to any significant remediation work.

Mr. Amos, Mr. Bratcher, Ms. Gregston:

At approximately 6:30 p.m. on 08/06/2012, and again at 7:30 a.m. on 08/07/2012, a produced water line leak was discovered near the above-referenced battery. Approximately 55 bbls of produced water was released during the first event and an additional 145 bbls was released during the second event. The releases was due to a fail in a weld on a poly line. A vacuum truck has recovered the free fluid. The poly has been re-fused and the line returned to service. We will obtain more details and submit a C-141. GPS coordinates, legal description, and driving directions below.
