The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received Rice Operating Company's report and request to close the above-referenced site, dated September 20, 2012. The report is acceptable to the OCD. Please submit to the OCD a plugging report for groundwater monitoring wells (MW-1 and MW-3) within 90 days.

The above-referenced report, submitted in accordance with 19.15.29 NMAC (Rule 29; formally, Rule 116), indicates that Rice Operating Company has met the requirements of 19.15.29 NMAC; therefore, the OCD approves the report and hereby notifies you that the remediation plan (1R426-101) is terminated in accordance with 19.15.29 NMAC.
