This office is in receipt of your application letter of January 18, 1995, wherein you have requested our approval to downhole commingle the Drinkard/Tubb oil & gas pools production from the above subject well.

It is our understanding that production from the subject well will be allocated as follows:

Tubb Pool	50%	59%

Since ownership is common throughout, and there will be no loss of revenue to the State of New Mexico's beneficiaries from your proposed operation, the Commissioner of Public Lands, this date approves your request.
