COMMINGLING ORDER PLC-266

The above-named company is hereby authorized to surface commingle gas production from the Basin-Dakota (Prorated Gas - 71599) and Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas - 71629) Pools from the following two diverse-ownership wells located on fee leases in San Juan County, New Mexico:

Armenta Gas Com "G" Well No. 2Y (API 30-045-32964)
Unit P, Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM
E/2 Dedication
Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool

Maddox Gas Com "C" Well No. 1E (API 30-045-23728)
Unit P, Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM
S/2 Dedication
Basin-Dakota Gas Pool

Each of the subject wells shall be equipped with an allocation meter that will continuously meter production prior to commingling. Gas production from each of the subject wells shall be determined by ratio utilizing allocation meter volumes and sales meter volumes. Compressor fuel usage shall be allocated based upon each well's production. The total production from all wells shall be metered by a gas sales meter located in Unit P of Section 27, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM. Liquids shall not be commingled.

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority. The operator shall notify the Aztec district office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
