RE: Injection Pressure Increase

Chalk Bluff Federal Well No. 1 Eddy County, New Mexico

Dear Mr. Morgan:

Reference is made to your request dated August 2, 2005, to increase the surface injection pressure on the Chalk Bluff Federal Well No. 1. This request is based on fracture data from the Chalk Bluff Federal Well No. 1, and from fracture data from offset wells producing from the Red Lake Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool. The fracture data shows that approval of an increase in surface injection pressure for this well will not result in the fracturing of the injection formation and confining strata.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected fluid is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
