Description: N/2 of Section 23, Township 16 South, Range 33 East, NMPM;

Wells: Gar State Well No. 2 (API No. 30-025-01264) Unit D, Section 23
Gar State Well No. 3 (API No. 30-025-37337) Unit A, Section 23
Gar State Well No. 4 (API No. 30-025-37366) Unit B, Section 23
Gar State Well No. 6 (API No. 30-025-37371) Unit C, Section 23

Lease: Carp State Lease (State Lease No. VB-646)
Description: S/2 of Section 23, Township 16 South, Range 33 East, NMPM;

Well: Potential well to be drilled on the Carp State Lease within the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 23.

(Note: Each of the subject wells is currently or will, in the near future, be downhole commingled in the Undesignated West Hume-Queen and Wildcat-Grayburg Pools)


Production from each of the subject state leases shall be metered separately prior to commingling.

Production shall be stored at a central tank battery located on the Gar State Lease and located in the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 23, Township 16 South, Range 33 East, NMPM.
