We have reviewed your correspondence dated May 20, 1996 regarding allocation of commingled production from the following well located on Federal lease SF 078046:

Hughs "B" #7A 1450' FNL, 1750' FWL, Section 29, T-29N, R-8W San Juan County, New Mexico

Your change in allocation is based on recommendations from this office outlined in correspondence dated November 27, 1995, and a change in your plans. Amoco amended their original plan to add compression to Pictured Cliffs production and will continue to produce into a low pressure gathering system. Your current proposal to allocate future, commingled, production based on extrapolated (non-compressed) Pictured Cliffs rates with the remainder of each months commingled volume allocated to the Mesaverde is hereby approved. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter which will result in equitable allocation to both formations.
