You have requested to drill this horizontal well at an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by the Special Rules and Regulations for the Scharb-Bone Spring Oil Pool, which provide for 80-acre units, with wells located not more than 200 feet from the center of a quarter-quarter section, and Rule 15.16.14.B(2) [19.15.16.14.B(2) NMAC] concerning directional wells in designated project areas. This location is unorthodox because portions of the proposed completed interval are closer than applicable rules permit to an outer boundary of the project area.
