While on his route the Lease Operator for the Apache 25 # 8 location discovered a water pump had went down causing tanks to run over into containment producing a 520 bbl. water spill with 520 bbls. recovered.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

After discovering the spill at the Apache 25 # 8 location, the Lease Operator called for trucks to clean up the spill, contacted his foreman, and then reset the pump to resume service.

At the Apache 25 #8 Salt Water Disposal, a water pump malfunctioned causing the water tanks to overflow resulting in a 520 bbl produced water spill with 520 bbl recovered.

Summary of What Happened?

At the Apache 25 #8 Salt Water Disposal, a water pump malfunctioned causing the water tanks to overflow resulting in a 520 bbl produced water spill with 520 bbl recovered.

An alarm went off at 4:01 PM on Saturday, October 13, 2012 at the Apache 25 # 8 SWD for pump malfunction and vibration. The lease operator for that area received a call at 6:14 PM about the alarm so he looked at SCADA, but everything appeared normal. He showed up at that location Sunday, October 14, 2012 and discovered that the tanks were running over and into the lined containment. The lease operator called for trucks to clean up the 520 bbl produced water spill. He then re-set the water pump to resume service. He called the foreman at 3:40 PM to report the spill who then called the superintendent. The foreman also contacted an EHS representative to report the spill.

OCD records show that number as a canceled/expired APD (expired in 1996). I believe the correct API number for this well/release should be 30-015-33439. Please advise if your records reflect differently, otherwise I will make the necessary corrections on this form.

There is an updated version of the C-141 form on the OCD website that does away with requesting the Lease number and asks for the API number. The inclusion of the API number on this form reduces confusion and is much appreciated on our end.
