Apache Corporation ("Apache"), is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from Monument; Yeso, Northwest Oil Pool (**97089**), and from the following Fee and State Leases and wells.

Monument Abo Well No. 1 (**API 30-025-26886**), Section 2, T-20-S, R-36-E.

Monument Abo 35 Well No. 2 (**API No. 30-025-33045**), Section 35, T-19-S, R-36-E.

**All in NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico**

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules and Regulations. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Hobbs District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
