The majority of the release was contained inside the walls of the tank battery. All free fluid has been recovered. Contaminated gravel has been removed from inside the facility and we have replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. The facility has been returned to its prior condition. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area outside of the lined facility to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
